ISWS Standard for the Silken Windhound

General Appearance: The Silken Windhound is an elegant, small to medium-sized sighthound with a moderately long silky coat. Its classic lines and athletic build are the hallmark of a true coursing dog. When viewing a Silken Windhound, one has the impression of grace, balance, and strength integrated with exceptional running ability.

Size, Proportion, Substance: The accepted measurements for Silken Windhounds are 18.5 -23.5 inches (47-60 cm) at the withers. Dogs over or under the ideal shall be penalized to the extent of the deviation. In proportion, Silken Windhounds are approximately square or slightly rectangular. Silkens that are excessively longer or shorter than they are tall should be penalized according to the extent of the deviation.

The build of the Silken Windhound is sleek, through a balanced combination of fine bladed bone and smooth muscle, and never looks frail. Heavy, round, or coarse bone is faulty.

Head: The Silken Windhound's expression is alert, friendly and intelligent. Eyes are rather large and dark, almondshaped and set somewhat obliquely. Pigment around eyes is full and dark. Ears are small and fine in texture, folded and lying back along the neck when in repose. When alert, ears may prick or semi-prick. Hanging, or drooping, houndy ears are undesirable. Moderately long in head, the Silken Windhound has a fairly narrow back skull which, when viewed from above, tapers gradually through a full muzzle to the nose. The muzzle is in good balance to the skull. When viewed from the side, the top plane of the muzzle is parallel to the plane of the flat skull, with a barely perceptible stop between.

The head is well chiseled, skin dry and tight, with noticeable veining. The nose is dark and may be slightly downturned at the end. Lips and flews are tight, in keeping with the dry head. Pigment on lips is full and dark. Jaws are strong to accommodate the teeth, which are large for a dog of this size, with full dentition and scissors bite. Missing teeth should be penalized.

Neck, Topline,Body: The neck is long and slender. It is slightly arched, well muscled, and powerful, never ewe necked. The neck is free from dewlap or throatiness, widening gradually and symmetrically into the shoulder. The topline rises gradually from slightly behind the withers, with the highest point of the arch being over the last rib, flowing smoothly over the muscular loin, carrying through and falling gradually over the long croup.

The back is short and the loin moderately long, wide, muscular, and arched. It is important that the loin be flexible to sustain and drive the double suspension gal- lop, which Silkens exhibit when running at top speed. A flat back with steep croup is not a loin arch and should be faulted. The chest is deep with moderate spring of rib. A barrel shaped or slab-sided body is faulty. The brisket reaches as nearly as possible to the elbow, with a graceful upsweep to the tuck-up; this creates the distinctive underline of the Silken Windhound. The tail is long and flexible, falling in a sweeping curve, free of kinks and reaching past the hock. When carried, the tail should not rise above the back. A tightly curled or gay tail is faulty.

Forequarters: The shoulder blades are well laid back and are long and smooth with flat muscle. Fine withers are preferred. Good return of upper arm is desirable, bringing the legs well under the withers. Elbows turn neither in nor out. The forelegs are straight and strong, with pasterns straight or slightly bent, but never knuckled over. Dewclaws on front legs are acceptable. The feet are well knuckled with tough, thick pads. Both the hare foot, with its longer middle toes; and the cat foot, with its shorter middle toes, is acceptable. Hare foot is preferred. Nails are strong and of moderate length.

Hindquarters: Hindquarters are well angulated, with a long second thigh and well-developed thigh muscles. Viewed from the rear, the hindquarters are slightly wider than the front, well muscled, without any suggestion of cow hocks. Stifles are well bent, and hock joints broad and strong. Hocks are short. Rear dewclaws may be removed. The feet are well knuckled with tough, thick pads. Both the hare foot, with its longer middle toes; and the cat foot, with its shorter middle toes, is acceptable. Hare foot is preferred. Nails are strong and of moderate length.

Coat: The coat is soft, and silky in texture. In no case should the coat be woolly or profuse enough to obscure the outline of the Silken Windhound, nor so long as to interfere with the function of a coursing hound. The coat may be straight, slightly wavy, or curly. There is longer feathering along the back of the forelegs, the brisket, hindquarters, around the neck, and tail. Coat on the face, feet, front of forelegs and hocks are naturally short. Feathering that frames the ears and face adds to the dog's expression and should not be trimmed. The Silken Windhound is shown in a natural coat with minimal trimming.

Color, Markings: All colors and markings are acceptable.

Gait: The Silken Windhound moves with a smooth effortless trot, which has good reach in front and good drive from the hindquarters. Restricted or wasted motion of the legs or body, when viewed from the side, is faulty. Paddling, hackneyed. gait, toeing in, and toeing out are faults in front movement. The hocks should not roll in or out when rear movement is viewed. While the hind legs are wider apart than the front, the feet, both front and rear, seek a center of balance closer to the centerline when the dog moves at a fast trot. Movement which is too wide, or too narrow, or which does not converge towards a centerline, is faulty.

Temperament: The Silken Windhound is an intelligent hound of balanced character. While this breed exhibits strong prey drive in the field, they are gentle, affectionate, devoted companion animals in the home. An unwarranted show of timidity or nervousness, or any sign of hostility towards people or dogs, should be penalized.

Chance Encounters and Determined Dreams:

A Partial History of the Establishment of Silken Windhound in Canada

Silkens in Canada: By the Numbers

Compared with Whippets, Borzoi or Greyhounds, there are fewer Silken Windhounds globally, including in Canada. As a comparatively new breed, there's growing awareness and recognition of Silkens. There's no simple way to know precisely how many Silken Windhounds have been placed in Canadian homes by breeders located in Canada or the US. The International Silken Windhound Society (ISWS) registration database can't provide this information at present.

An approximation of the number of Silkens in Canada:

Silken litters and puppies born in Canada (since 2007):

40 litters and 247 puppies

Silken puppies and adults placed in Canada by US breeders (since 2007):

59 Puppies and 25 Adults

Canadian Silken Tales

Silken Windhound owners tend to be passionately engaged with their dogs and often report falling in love with Silkens at first sight. Many owners tell a story about a chance encounter with Silkens, where they were going to get another breed, often another Sighthound, and then cast their eyes on their first Silken and never looked back. To build a picture of the establishment of Silkens in Canada, we asked Canadians to share stories and photos.

Silkens in Canada: First 3 Canadian Silken Owner Homes

Harriett Lemer and Ron Einblau, Vancouver, BC:

They took our breath away. It was as simple and as complicated as that. In early 2001 we were an hour from Vancouver looking at Whippets for our next family dog. And

there they were, Kristull Irish Ash and Kristull Egyptian Beauty – Canada's first two Silkens. He in the corner watching us and she jumping up onto my lap uninvited. It was love at first sight for all four of us. Ron and I (and everyone else in Canada) had never seen anything like them. They came to live with us about two months later. "Ash" was handsome, regal and dignified.

While guiet, adventurous, and headstrong he purred when you rubbed his ears. "Ruby", as we named her, was beautiful, wiggly, and silly. With a big personality she was built for love and attention. We travelled to Seattle to meet with Alison Brendel who assessed that they were a good match and in the interests of this new-to-Canada breed they had their first, and only litter together in 2004, bred here and whelped at Tangaloor. Ash went on to sire three more litters. Their pup Tangaloor Raincoast Quatsino ("Tango"), the first Canadian puppy, came home to Vancouver in 2004. We enjoyed and marvelled at how the three of them brought new meaning to our lives and to passersby. We en-joyed welcoming visitors to our home to meet them as word got out about Silken Windhounds. That was 21 years ago, and we were privileged to be deeply inspired by them. In their memory we have and will continue to dedicate ourselves toward recognition of this amazing breed in Canada.

Dave and Marg, Kelowna, BC:

My original search for the "right" dog was quite protracted as Silkens were largely unknown in the early 2000's, and though I thought there was a breed for every niche, the only mid-sized sighthounds with a longer coat were Walter Wheeler's Longhaired Whippets or Taigans. The first Silkens I met in person were Ash and Ruby (belonging to Ron and Harriett) in 2002. Marg would have rather had a cat and had previously had Whippets and she said they were the most "cat-like" dog she knew of.

In 2003, I brought home "Q'uva" from Allagante Silkens (Karen Sanders). He was an incredibly sweet natured dog, finding favour even amongst those who "don't like dogs," making him a great Silken ambassador.

Shannon Anselmo, Vancouver, BC:

I saw my first Silken Windhound in 2002 in Central Park, Burnaby, BC just minutes after saying goodbye to my 13-yearold Borzoi, "Roxanne". The Silkens I saw that fateful day were walking with Harriett and her husband Ron.

I had several Borzoi in the past and once I had met Silken Windhounds I knew that their size would be perfect as I 'matured'. Silkens have a look similar to Borzoi. My first Silken, "Echo" (Tangaloor Captain Sheridan) was 1.5 years old when he came home to live with me (in 2003). I find Silkens to be fun, great company as well as fantastic conversation starters. I have become a better dog trainer through my experiences with Silkens. My heart belongs to Silken Windhounds.

Silken Events in Canada Earliest Large Silken Windhound UKC Show Entry (2016)

The inaugural Canadian Silken Windhound Booster was hosted by the Grand River Kennel Club UKC in Rockton, ON (May 1, 2016). This event included a record-setting entry of Silkens for any Canadian dog show event! The Canadianowned Silkens entered in this show included: "Kohl" (Starfyre Chrysocolla), "Suki," (Allagante My Sweet Suki) "Cher" (Starfyre Charoite), "Adele" (Broadway's Class at Runway), "Davey" (Broadway's Seize the Day at Runway), "Willow" (Springlane's Selene), and "Devon" (Winsome's Driving Force).

First International Silken Windhound Society Sanctioned Speciality in Canada (2022)

Host: Canadian Silken Windhound Society, Coordinated by Alex Kovacs, Navy Rose Silkens, Airdrie, AB.

There are only a few UKC shows available in Canada, and they are typically in Central Canada or on the West Coast. The time is right to have a Canadian ISWS Specialty (International Silken Windhound Society). If we want breed recognition, then we need to show the dog community that we are serious in our intent. I sought permission from the ISWS Board and we forged ahead. Both judges are extremely well known and respected hound judges with the CKC and open to judging a rare breed. I am really looking forward to seeing as many Silken Windhounds as possible in one place here in Canada and to get puppy owners to show off their pups in a friendly and collegial environment. We hope that everyone who joins us will enjoy their Specialty experience and Alberta hospitality.

Silkens in Canada: Today's Canadian Owners Coast to Coast

Canada is home to Silkens from coast to coast as more people learn about this in- credible breed. In this history, we have stories from Silken owners and breeders in British Columbia, Alberta, Saskatchewan, Ontario and Quebec. Here are several additional stories about Silken owners from West to East.

Kelly and Pauline Ng: British Columbia.

Kelly learned about Silkens (~2011) when she saw a Petfinder listing for a "Borzoi x Sheltie," which the listing clarified was a Silken Windhound. We often ogled Allagante's Puppy page. We met our first Silkens at a meet-up in the summer of 2015. We saw James' Silken, "Scout", frolicking over the hill. She was like a unicorn! We were hooked. We got our first silken, "Podzol", from Melissa Pearce (Attaway Jaguarundi) in 2017. We got our second silken, "Aguila", in 2021 (Attaway Running with the Night). It was quite the journey having met the first Silken in Canada, Ash, and being able to watch the local community grow to over 20 Silkens! Today, we are seriously involved in dog sports, and proud that Podzol is the first Canadian Silken to receive an AFSA Field Champion (FCh) title, as well as a LGRA Gazehound Racing Champion (GRC) title, which he obtained in 2019. In 2020, we decided on the kennel name "Hounds of Qilin". As a breed hobbyist, our primary goal is to raise the profile of Silkens by showing in conformation, racing, and organizing Silken meetups. Should we ever plan on breeding, our focus will be a Silken who is balanced in conformation and performance, as well as sound in temperament and health.

Drew: Nova Scotia.

I had never heard of the breed before talking with Michèle Fink about Borzois. I was interested in a smaller sighthound, coming from many years with Greyhounds. I wanted another sighthound that would enjoy doing things with me, like camping, travelling, city living, and meeting new people. Fast-forward a few months and I was driving an hour and a half to go meet my transport contact and pick up little "Lumi" (Secret Haven's Luminescence). Lumi improves my quality of life. She is my first dog to be involved in sports - we do Rally Obedience and Agility (very beginner!). It's so much fun learning with her and growing as a team. I sincerely hope to

see more Silkens in Nova Scotia this year. They are truly a beautiful breed, inside and out. I hope many people will get to appreciate Silkens like we do.

Sonya and Bill: Newfoundland.

I was researching Whippets when I came across Silken Windhounds. I was intrigued. The size, temperament and beauty of the breed all seemed to fit. "Lukey" had a great road travel adventure getting to St. John's, NL. He travelled from Secret Haven to St. John's via a network of truckers coordinating transfers and delivery. Lukey (Secret Haven Lemongrass) arrived safe and sound. It seems now that he has always been here. We were meant to be. His name 'Lukey' is from the song by the Newfoundland band Great Big Sea, "Lukey's Boat". Lukey has been everything I expected plus more. He is such a smart and well-behaved puppy. I couldn't imagine life without him!

Canadian Silken Breeders

First Silken Litter: Born in Canada

Susan April, Sangilak: Saskatchewan.

I met Harriett Lemer and Ron Einblau and their Silkens on a trip to Vancouver. We became friends through our mu-tual interest in the breed and through this friendship plans were made for the first Canadian Silken Windhound litter. The first Canadian Silken Windhound litter was born March 9, 2007. The sire was Kristull Irish Ash and the dam was Allagante Calypso. There were 3 males and 2 females in the litter. Female pups: silver brindle with white and a spotted red brindle on white. Male pups: Irish- marked red brindle, black brindle with white and a silver boy who took after his Dad. I breed because there are qualities in a dog that I' d like to keep. In "Calypso's" case I was looking for another athletic and willing dog to do agility. I believe that Sangilak Raincoast Carlea from the Calypso/Ash litter and her sister Sangilak Raincoast Victoria may be the two oldest Silkens in Canada.

First Silken Litter: Born in Quebec (April 9, 2022)

Made In Canada: Canadian Silken Breeders

Raincoast Windhounds: Harriett Lemer and Ron Einblau, British Columbia. In 2001 Raincoast Windhounds became the home of Canada's first two Silken Windhounds. Kristull Egyptian Beauty ("Ruby") and Kristull Irish Ash ("Ash"). Ash achieved ISWS Ch. on July 19, 2008. Ash sired four litters, the first with "Ruby" in 2004, conceived in Canada and whelped at Tangaloor by Alison Brendel. In 2007 he sired the first litter conceived and whelped in Canada with Allagante Sangilak Calvpso. Ash and Ruby were joined by their son Raincoast Tangaloor Quatsino ("Tango"), Canada's first puppy (2004), and later by Allagante Taj-I-Mah ("Taj"). Raincoast Allagante Cleopatra ("Cleo") had one litter in Washington and lives in Oregon with Wyndolyn Silkens. Her daughter Raincoast Allagante Miracle ("Mira") had two litters in Oregon where she lived until her passing. After two litters, her daughter UKC Ch. Allagante Raincoast Lindy Hop ("Lindy") retired to us from JoyRun Silkens with the help of co-breeder, Karen Sanders. Lindy is the great granddaughter of Kristull Irish Ash and so the circle at Raincoast from our first Silken Windhounds is completed.

As a small urban kennel, Raincoast relied on collaborative breeding in order to draw on the expertise and guidance of well-respected breeders in the Pacific Northwest. We were committed to well structured, healthy, happy, and well socialized SilkenWindhounds. At this time, we have made the choice to focus our attention on being Silken Windhound ambassadors in Canada. We launched the success- ful Canadian Silken Windhound Facebook page, and actively work to enhance awareness, knowledge and love of this special breed. We are delighted that from 2001 with two Silken Windhounds, the Canadian population has grown in 2022 to over 250 Silkens with new Silkens being bred in Canada and coming to Canada regularly.

Zephyr Silken Windhounds: Leah Blackwood, British Columbia. My first Silken was "Jasper", UKC GR Ch. ISWS Ch. Winsome's Here Comes the Sun. I got him in 2014. My second was UKC Ch. Winsome's Cassidy. I bred "Cassidy" with the in- tent of keeping a puppy, which I did from her second litter. None has been shown yet. I have no current plans for breeding.

Navy Rose Silkens: Alex Kovacs, Alberta. My first Silken was Kristull Y Not ("Breanna"). I got her the summer of 2006 after meeting and falling in love with the breed. I like Silkens' compact size. And yet, I was drawn more to the ones that looked more Borzoi-ish. After talking with Chris Swilley who leased her male to me, Kristull Wind Walker ("Warrick") in 2007, I had my first litter January 24, 2008: 7 beautiful healthy puppies. CH Dreamland's Njord was my first and only UKC Ch which he obtained in 2010 after going Best in Show in the USA. I have bred 4 litters - 23 puppies. My most exciting litter was my first (2008). It was the 2nd Silken litter born in Canada. My top goal for the next five years is to unite the Canadian Breeders and obtain Silken Windhound breed recognition by the Canadian Kennel Club. https://www.facebook.com/lexy.kovacsnavyroseborzoi

Sangilak: Susan April, Saskatchewan. I showed and bred Borzoi under the kennel name Sangilak. I got interested in Silken Windhounds after losing a very special bitch to torsion. The Silkens had similarities to the Borzoi, were a size better suited to agility, and most importantly, did not have torsion as a health concern. My first Silken was Allagante Calypso. She was born Feb 28/2004 and came to Canada when she was 11 weeks old. At the time I was told that she was the 5th Silken to come to Canada, Conformation showing wasn't an option here at that time so "Calypso" became the first Silken in Canada to do agility. She was the first Silken to be listed in the NADAC (North American Dog Agility Council) Top 10 by breed list for agility and I believe that she was the first silken with an AAC (Agility Association of Canada) title. The first Canadian Silken Windhound litter was born March 9, 2007. The sire was Kristull Irish Ash and the dam was Allagante Calypso. Finding homes was challenging since the breed was so un-known at that time. Harriett and the exposure her Silkens got in Vancouver was very helpful. Because it was a first, this is probably the most exciting litter that I've bred. Due to various circumstances, I have not bred another Silken litter but I hope to do so in the

Astraeus Silkens: Lisa Adams Finlay, Ontario. My first Silken was UKC Ch, ISWS Ch Springlane's Selene ("Willow"). I had never met any Silkens in person, but had done extensive research and communicated with several breeders. We drove from Toronto to Akron. Ohio to meet Willow, her litter, and her mom. We drove home the following day (November 4, 2012) with our little Willow to start her life with us. About a year later I was looking for a second female Silken and Jolene Hicks offered me "Cher" (UKC Ch, ISWS Ch Starfyre Charoite). Two years later I was offered a spectacular breeding opportunity for Cher. Given that Willow and Cher had both done extremely well in the show ring and Willow was 10 months older than Cher, I decided that if I was going to be a breeder. I would breed Willow first. She had four lovely little girls with "Ranger" (SummersSpirit Chipotle). My first homebred CH is "Minett". She is a UKC GRCH (with all five points earned in a total of six shows). I've bred two litters with

litter have had much success, both in the show ring as well as in performance sports. My singleton was born during the pandemic so hasn't yet had a chance to show us what she can do. July 14th (2022), in a co-breeding with The Hounds of Springlane, Minett welcomed a lovely litter of three boys and a girl. We can't wait to see what these pups will do. https://astraeus-silkens.ca/

Secret Haven Kennel/ Élevage Secret Haven: Michèle Fink, Ontario. In 2011 I met a Borzoi owner (Daniel Gauvin) who was showing a beautiful black Borzoi. I asked him where he got her (Mary Childs: WindnSatin). I contacted Mary Childs, made a trip to Ohio to pick up my first self black Borzoi puppy and was intro- duced to Silken Windhounds at that time. I got to spend some time watching and observing Silken puppies run and play. When I left Mary's, I told her that I would be back for a Silken Windhound. She said, "See you!". In 2014, Mary advised me that she had a six-month-old black Irish-marked boy who was show/breeding potential. I jumped on that. I travelled to Ohio and picked up my beautiful boy, WindnSatin Diamonds at Midnite. That was the start of a whole new adventure!

Mary introduced me to UKC and helped me show "Diamond". In 2016, Diamond got his UKC Championship, his ISWS

championship, his UKC Grand Championship and made the UKC Top Ten. Diamond has gone on to produce some astonishing get. His progeny are helping me build interest in this amazing breed in Canada. My top goal is to reach the trifecta of excellence in breeding Silkens, which would be to produce a dog that is healthy, has a good temperament and is put together with a structure that meets the breed standard._http://www.secrethavenkennel.com/

Runway Silken Windhounds: Cathie Leloff, Ontario. I was at a UKC show (2016) in the ring showing a Whippet (won the Group) when I turned around, so that I could see who was behind me. There was a magnificent black chinchilla Silken being shown by Lisa Adams Finlay. From that day forward I have been in love with Silken Windhounds. My first Silken was "Adele" (Broadway's Class at Runway) and then "Davey" (Broadway's Seize the Day at Runway). Adele has produced some of the best puppies that I have ever seen. I am proud of the Runway puppies. Two were recently placed in Norway and one in Wales. In my planning for my breeding program, I am focused on producing a Silken who meets the Breed Standard in the manner laid out by Francie Stull at the 2022 Silkenfest. Good structure is essential to all the performance sports, such as to provide sup- port for the rear drive in racing. Temperament is also crucial. ISWS Conformation Show Rules and Awards

(Amended, applying to these shows)

This Specialty show is held under the guidelines of the International Silken Windhound Society (ISWS).

Please refer to schedule for additional information.

Regular Classes - Points awarded in Regular Classes contribute towards an ISWS Champion title.

Winners – The Winners Class shall be open only to undefeated dogs of the same sex, which have won first prize from the regular classes. After the Winners prize has been awarded in one of the sex divisions, the second prize wining dog, if un- defeated except by the dog awarded Winners, shall compete with the other eligible dogs for Reserve Winners. No eligible dog may be withheld from competition. ISWS Champions are excluded from these awards.

Best in Show – The following categories of dogs are eligible to compete in this competition: ISWS Champions, Winners Dog, Winners Bitch in this event, Veterans winners in this event.

Best of Winners – If Winners Dog or Winners Bitch is awarded Best in Show, it shall be automatically awarded Best of Winners; otherwise, the Winners Dog and Winners Bitch shall be judged together for Best of Winners following the judging of Best in Show. The dog awarded Best of Winners shall be credited with the num- ber of points calculated for Winners Dog or Winners Bitch whichever is greater. In the event that Winners is awarded in only one sex, there shall be no Best of Winners award.

Best of Opposite Sex – After Best in Show and Best of Winners have been awarded the judge shall select Best of Opposite Sex to Best in Show. Eligible for this award are:

Dogs of the opposite sex to Best in Show that have been entered in the Best in

Show competition. The dog awarded Winner of the opposite sex to Best in Show.

Best Puppy, Best Junior and Best Veteran — will be awarded after Best in Show. Dogs competing for these awards are not limited to the Puppy, Junior and Veteran classes providing they are unbeaten by a dog/bitch in their respective age category. Additional Special Awards for their regular classes will follow Best Veteran.

Allocation of Points:

For the CSWS Specialty Shows the ISWS point will be awarded to the highest plac- ing non-champion dog and bitch following the point schedule below. All Regular Classes will be included in counting points for each sex. The Winners dog or Winners bitch awarded Best in Show counts all defeated Champions of both sexes in addition to the dogs that competed in the regular classes for its sex.

In counting eligible dogs in competition, a dog that is disqualified, dismissed, excused or ordered from the ring by the judge, or from which all awards are with- held, shall not included.

The dog must be individually registered with the ISWS to be eligible for an ISWS championship.

Non Regular Classes

Altered Classes - The points contributed towards an Altered ISWS Champion

Altered Winners Dog and Altered Winners Bitch earn points according to the schedule below:

Number of dogs in each sex 1 2 3 4 5 6+ Number of points awarded 0 1 2 3 4 5

Altered Winners - This is for those undefeated dogs of the same sex that have won first-place from the non-regular classes. Altered Winners Dog and Altered Winners Bitch are both eligible for points toward an ISWS Altered Championship.

Best Altered In Show - The following are eligible to participate in this competition: Altered ISWS Champions, Altered Winners Dog and Altered Winners Bitch.

Best Altered Winner - If Altered Winners Dog or Altered Winners Bitch is awarded Best Altered, it shall automatically be awarded Best of Winners. Following the judging of Best Altered.

The dog awarded Altered Best of Winners shall be credited with the number of points calculated for Altered Winners Dog or Altered Winners Bitch, whichever is greater.

Best Altered of Opposite Sex - After Best Altered and Altered Best of Winners have been awarded, the judge shall select

Altered Best of Opposite Sex to Best Altered.

Dogs eligible for this award are:

Dogs of the opposite sex to Best Altered who have been entered in the Best Altered competition.

The dog awarded Altered Winners of the opposite sex to the Best Altered.

Stud Dog, Brood Bitch Classes – Open to dogs and bitches that have sired or whelped two or more dogs or bitches entered in the show. A minimum of 2 and a maximum of 4 progeny may be shown in the class. The Stud Dog or Brood Bitch must appear in the ring with the progeny and be entered in the class. The owner of the Stud Dog or Brood Bitch is not required to be owner of the progeny. The award, although given to the Stud Dog or Brood Bitch is based upon the merits of the offspring.

Brace - a Brace is defined as two dogs of the same breed that are similar in ap- pearance, performing in unison and presented by a maximum of one handler. This class is judged 40% of conformation, 40% on matching looks, and 20% on difficulty of the match. Entries in this class **are not required to be intact**, **to be the same sex or to be entered in any regular class**. Both dogs must have one common owner.

Eligible Dogs in Competition

In counting eligible dogs in competition, a dog that is disqualified, dismissed, excused or ordered from the ring by the judge, or from which all awards are with- held, shall not be included

The dog must be individually registered with the ISWS to be eligible for an ISWS championship.
